Safety Tips

Reduce your risk of auto theft with these tips:

- Lock your doors and roll up your windows.
- Leave valuables—including spare change and sunglasses—out of sight.
- Do not hide a spare key or keyless car remote in your car.
- If you can, choose a parking spot in a well-lit area close to your destination.
- Never leave your car running unattended.
- Look in your car before entering to check for unwanted occupants. Lock your doors once you get inside.
- Be aware of your surroundings and report suspicious activity by calling your property’s security patrol. For emergencies, call 911.
