





In January 2021, Aeon broke ground on The Sound on 76th in Edina. This new property would give residents access to a community with a high quality of life that had historically been out of reach due to housing costs.

Thanks to you, in April 2022, residents like Ali and his family moved into the 70 new homes at The Sound on 76th.

Ali was born in Somalia in 1950. He earned his master's degree in chemistry and started a family.

In 1991, the civil war in Somalia made life there dangerous. Ali and his family fled to Kenya, where they lived for nine years in refugee camps before resettling in the United States.

But Ali couldn't find a job in his field. He had to take minimum wage work in a factory. To get by, Ali's family shared housing with others—as many as 12 people living together. Without affordable housing there was no other option.

Then, some of Ali's family told him about Aeon. Now, Ali lives with his wife and two youngest children at Aeon's newest property.

Thanks to you, 70 individuals and families, like Ali's, have access to the resources Edina has to offer, and homes where they can thrive.

"We all have different stories," Ali says, "But we have all found a home here at The Sound. This home is a blessing, and I am so grateful."
